CONNECTING COMMUNITIES THROUGH MIG PROJECTS

Intsika Yethu Municipality has embarked on a series of Municipal Infrastructure Grant (MIG) handover projects that are aimed to improve roads infrastructure and create job opportunities for local residents. These initiatives were announced by the Mayor's Office on 4 August 2025.

Ward 6 – Bridges Project

The community of ward 06 has been approved two bridges that will be constructed over the period of six months to improve connectivity in the area.

Ward 8 – Tsomo Taxi Rank

Construction of Tsomo Taxi Rank commenced on the 5 August and will and is expected to be completed in 09 months time. This facility will make commuting safer and more efficient.

Ward 14 – Ekuphumleni Access Road

The construction of the access road have commenced already upgrading the access road in Ekuphumleni, a six-month project that will improve access to essential services.

The construction will have a positive impact on the local economy of Intsika Yethu as most of the sub-contractors are locals. Furthermore all labour is sourced from the communities where the projects are based, ensuring that residents benefit directly through employment opportunities and skills development.

“These projects improve infrastructure while creating real opportunities for our people,” said the mayor, Cllr Kanyiswa Mdleleni. The municipality remains committed to delivering quality infrastructure that meets the needs of all wards.
